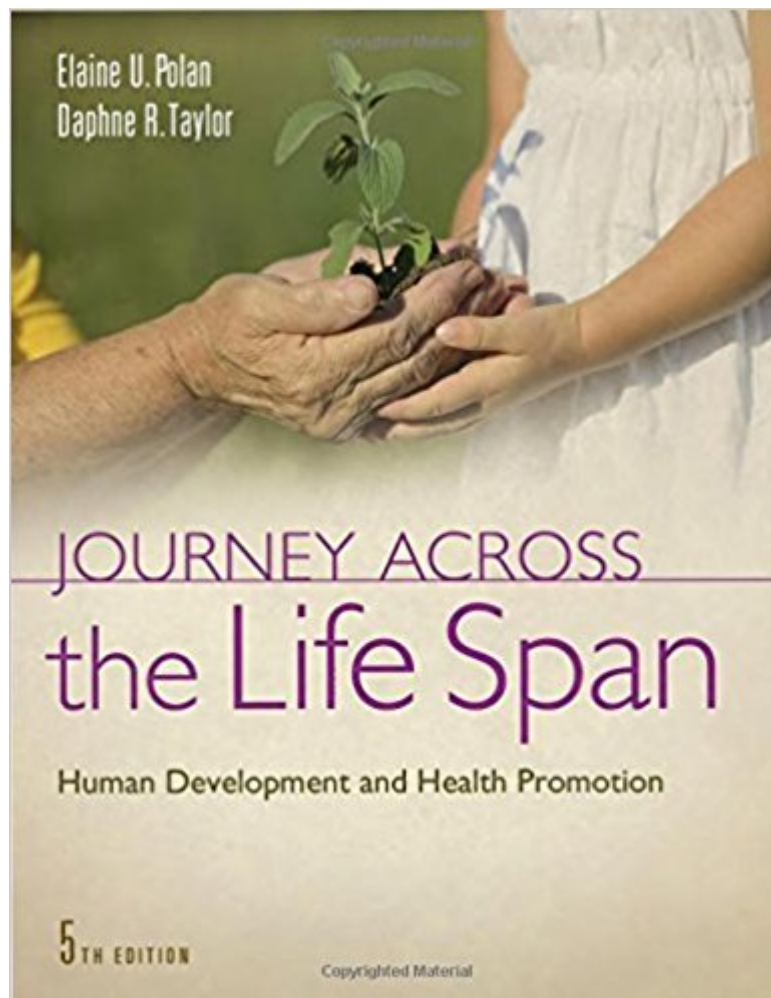




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Journey Across The Life Span: Human Development And Health Promotion
