This new saga in Allie and Revik's lives is even better than the previous one. Allie and Revik have finally decided on no more separations. They are in this forever, together. They do a lot of reconnecting in every way. Other characters have the opportunity to find their mates as well. These relationships are so passionate, intimate, and touching that you just can't put this book down. The characters have a closeness that is only found in the best written romances. Then there are multiple layers of politics, science fiction, suspense and action supporting all of that intense feeling. So much planning and skill goes into these novels I can't say enough about them. They can't be easy to write but they are so enjoyable to read.

Another great addition to this series. As with the others in this newly edited series it's been rewritten pretty heavily, but definitely for the better! There is even more depth to the characters in this one than original, giving a deeper understanding of their motives and feelings. This book has such a pivotal role in the series really setting you up to see how well Allie and Revik work together, without

the drenges influencing them. We also get a glimpse into Jon and his POV for a good chunk of this book, which is probably my favorite part. This gives such a different (human) perspective to the larger events that are unfolding as well as more meaning behind who the Bridge's brother is and his role in the displacement. It's definitely worth continuing the series if you're reading this new version and especially worth reading if you've read the old version.

In case you haven't guessed from my previous reviews of the preceding volumes, I love this series. Love it. The relationship between Allie and Revik reaches a new and satisfyingly complex level within the pages of this book. Honestly, I kept waiting for the torture to begin again, for these two to be wrenched apart in the most frustrating of ways again. Instead, they are faced with a completely different set of challenges, as are the characters around them. The complex plotting and the misdirection, the drama, the unexpected snapshots of love all weave together to produce a strong series addition. Once again, an action packed book. I couldn't put it down. I voluntarily reviewed an advanced reader copy of this book.

KNIGHT by JC Andrijeski is one of the most powerfully emotional books in the series to date. This revised version, is still packed with action and emotional development, but I also found it made it FAR MORE challenging to put the book aside for "real-life" necessities (like sleep, eating, etc.) than its predecessor. The original edition of this book was heavy with descriptions and minutiae that could derail the lighter reader at times. I have been a HUGE JC Andrijeski fan since Allie & Revik hooked me with the first book in this story several years ago. In fact, they can be credited for my voracious appetite for reading all of JC's work. Knight: The Bridge and Sword, is somehow more succinct without losing the imagery that allows Andrijeski's readers to escape fully into the world she creates for them. The thoughts and feelings of several characters are more flushed out in this installment, and Allie and Revik are not the only ones to explore the depth of their feelings about one another. There are some truly touching moments to be found in KNIGHT and Andrijeski continues to make sure that none of her characters are depicted as static or two-dimensional. Traitors are exposed, lives within the inner-circle lost, and still the reader is left wondering if some of the "bad-guys" are really that easy to label. Do yourself a favor and grab a copy of KNIGHT. The Bridge & Sword Saga crosses multiple genres and will appeal to a wide audience!
