Because of a lack of scientific information, marijuana came to be known as a harmless drug. The marijuana of the 21st Century, however, is far more powerful than ever before in its history of use. Contemporary scientific research has proven that marijuana is neither killer weed nor harmless. Rather, its effects are somewhere between these extremes. Many users of marijuana are exposed to marijuana in childhood. Because they are still developing physically, emotionally and mentally, marijuana use in youth is especially dangerous. One of its most significant effects is short-term memory loss. Children who use marijuana may also
