


The book was found

Here we have the Unlikely Heroes book #6, and it's terrific ! Trenton, 21, a good looking rookie firefighter, with dirty blonde hair and hazel eyes, is a hard worker. He sees his newly found brother and his partner, plus all of their group, living openly and have that special bond that he wants with his "one" someday. We get his back story of family, coming out, and a heartless ex. Kade, 29, is a hunky cop, dark hair and eyes, with his sweet daughter, 22 month old, Emmi. His best friend Sara died from cancer so he and his daughter and sister, Callie, do pretty well together. The men see each other a few times, and once again at a BBQ with friends. Then - at a fire scene of a Meth Lab, the freaked out Meth guy slashes Trenton's arm with a broken bottle. Kade remains at his side, and after shots, stitches, meds, and sleep, Trenton opens his eyes. He then ends up at Kade's, becoming Emmi's favorite person, Boo-boo ! Of course, then Kade makes a dumb move, and soon must make up for it. Kade is in the closet, wanting desperately to be out, but on the police force there are stories of homophobes not helping out their partners. He has to think of Emmi and Callie. But also, he can't stop thinking of Trenton. They begin hanging out more, with long talks, family time, and super hot sexy times. This "family" of men are amazing, and we get to feel close to all of them. Jenny Woods characters weave their way into our hearts. Simply fabulous tales of special people who deserve good times, amidst the sometimes cruel world. These series stories can stand alone. The grammatical errors get worse and worse through the series and it totally distracts from a fantastic story. I understand you are an amateur writer, and for that I graciously applaud you. However, 90% of the errors are easily corrected as it's mostly punctuation and typo's. If anything have another set or two of eyes read prior to publishing.

I have really enjoyed all of these books. However, there continues to be too many grammatical errors. Not as many errors as was in the first few books but still enough to be annoying. For example, the words brake and break were used incorrectly and there were several commas where none were needed which made it a little confusing at times. The author is a great story teller but really needs a better editor.

I really liked this book , it's not easy raising a daughter on your own. But Kade was lucky to have great sister . Kade found love when he lease expected . He also found a reason to come out of the closet at work .
