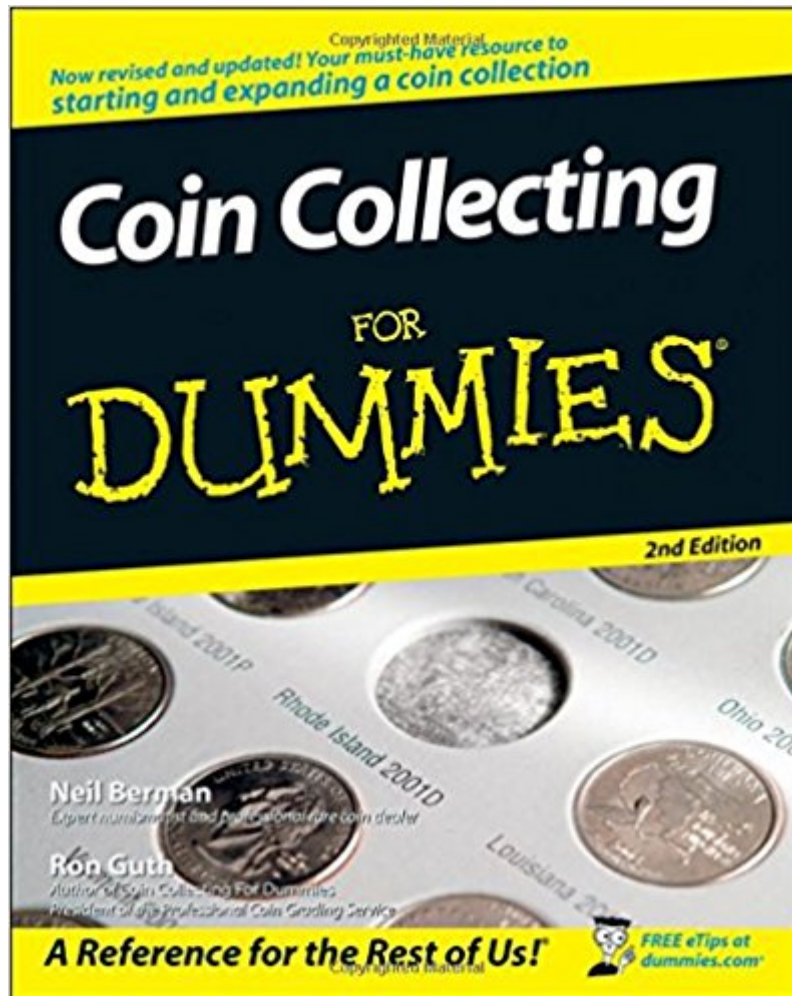

The book is written in plain English and is logically divided into parts, chapters, sub-chapters, and tinged up with funny examples and style. On the other hand, authors should have paid more attention to cleaning coins, numismatic catalogs and should have paid less attention to American coins. Numismatics – as a part of Auxiliary Sciences of History – is beautiful hobby and this book & handbook, or rather these two authors are willing to help to build your collection and your skills.

The "Dummies" series books are generally very good and this one is no exception. If you want to begin coin collecting or even if you think you know more about the subject than most people, you'll still find this book to be informative.
