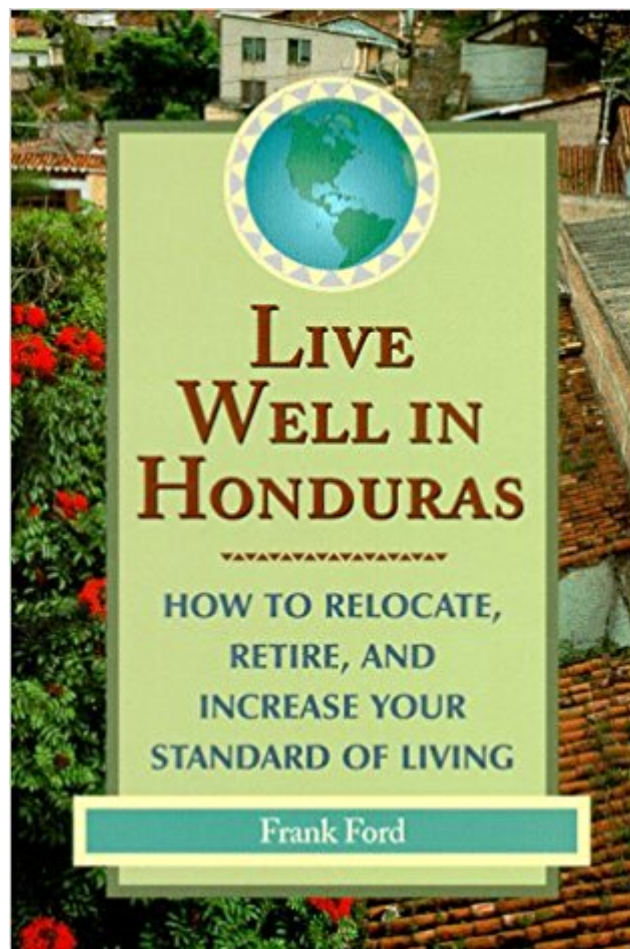




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DEL-Live Well In Honduras: How To Relocate, Retire, And Increase Your Standard Of Living
