

Jez Tuya is a New Zealand-based freelance illustrator, specializing in character design and children's illustration. While he creates his illustrations digitally they are rich in texture, detail and atmosphere which gives them a hand-rendered quality.

Most kids can probably tell you who Amelia Earhart is. She was a pilot who disappeared. But it is her life that is fascinating. As with her biography of George Ferris, author Barbara Lowell finds those interesting facts that pull kids into Earhart's story. Like Pearl Carter Scott and Bessie Coleman, Earhart broke new ground to become an early aviator. Knowing what she was like as a kid makes it seem perfectly natural that she would try to fly around the world. She is a role model for youngsters who have their own non-traditional dreams, and I am happy to put this charming easy reader on my classroom shelf.
