

Anyone who can follow this book doesn't need it. Great illustrations ÃƒÂ¢Ã ¬Ã • superficial discussion.I am a retired Mechanical Engineer and general handyman. I build furniture and have drawn up plans for two houses, so I probably have more knowledge than the average homeowner, yet I found this book lacking in substance and difficult to follow.I am now in my 70s and this book looked like a great reference for my wife who statistically should outlive me. With so many great illustrations, I thought that it would be a great way to answer many of the questions that she has started asking as the reality of our age and mortality becomes more real every day.Personally, just having the illustrations is advantageous to me. If I know how something is constructed, I can usually fix it. I had hoped for more. The first section of the book covered plumbing. The only thing that I was interested in is the venting system. We had a house some years ago that would vent sewer gases through the roof vents from time to time. I was never able to identify the source of the problem. We had several plumbers come to the house but they were just as mystified as we were. I hoped that this book might give me a clue about this problem. It did not.What really surprised me was the text that accompanied the illustration of the venting system. It was more gibberish than any thing else. I re-read several sentences three or four times before I finally accepted that this author is incapable of explaining anything.As I continued to read the book, this lack of information proved to be the norm rather than the exception.The book needs at least three or four times as many illustrations and clear identification of how things are assembled and the function of each part if it is to have any relevance to the average homeowner.One Star might seem a bit harsh for such a wonderfully illustrated book but a collection of illustrations does not make a How-To book.

Very good reference material stated in layman terms. Gives you a chance to understand the basics of what is in your house and how it is supposed to function.

This is an excellent reference for someone getting to know the home as a sum of parts. I bought this for friends who recently bought a new home and do not have construction experience. This text is
