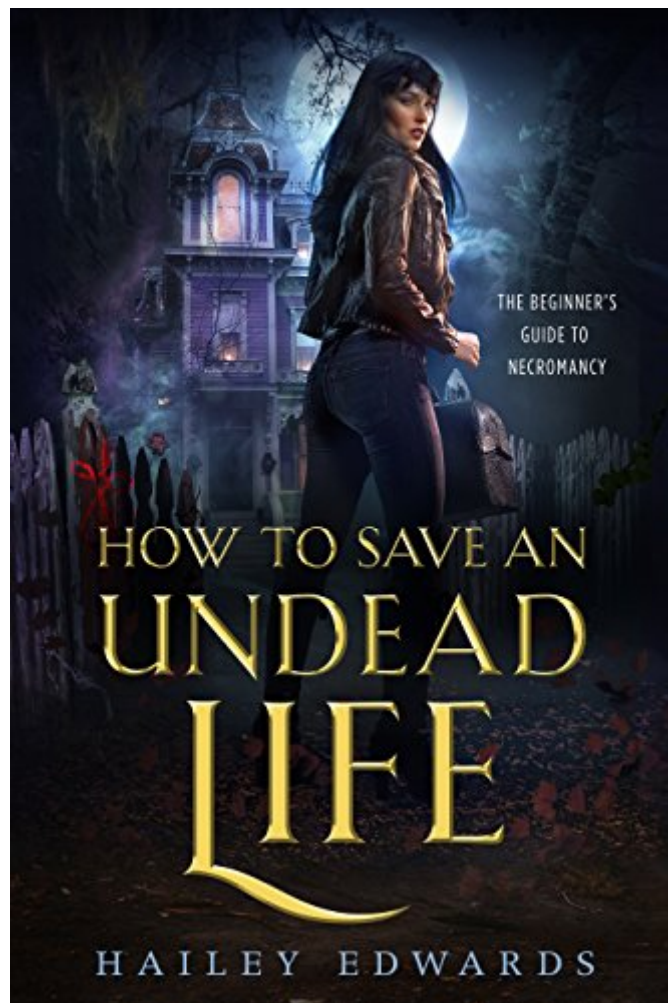




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How To Save An Undead Life (The Beginner's Guide To Necromancy Book 1)
