

I read everything I can find about the Book of Enoch as it is necessary to understanding much of church tradition. This translation, with commentary by Joseph B. Lumpkin, is as good as it gets. The timetable on pages 178-179 is extremely helpful. Though this is a scholarly text, it is also a good read. If you are just discovering "Enoch" I recommend reading it in the heat of summer as it will chill you to the bone and you won't need to run your air conditioner. This was a good history lesson of the true origins of angels/man and how they both failed God and started practicing evil. It also dips onto the workings of the universe. Some of it is unverifiable but not necessarily incorrect. It starts out with some really interesting history.

A couple of comments here. This is a good listen on Audible, however when using Audible the chapter list does not match the actual location in the book. I have found this to be true with other Audible books as well, so this makes it hard to know exactly where one is for future reference. Secondly, on the Audible chapter list showing chapter 93, the reader is actually at chapter 90. At the end of this chapter 90 the reader makes a mistake where in verse 17 it reads "Here now, my children, and walk in the path of righteousness, but shun that of oppression; for all who walk in the path of iniquity shall perish for ever"....the reader's mistake is that he says "...for all who walk in the path of righteousness shall perish for ever". I'm sure he meant to read "unrighteousness"
