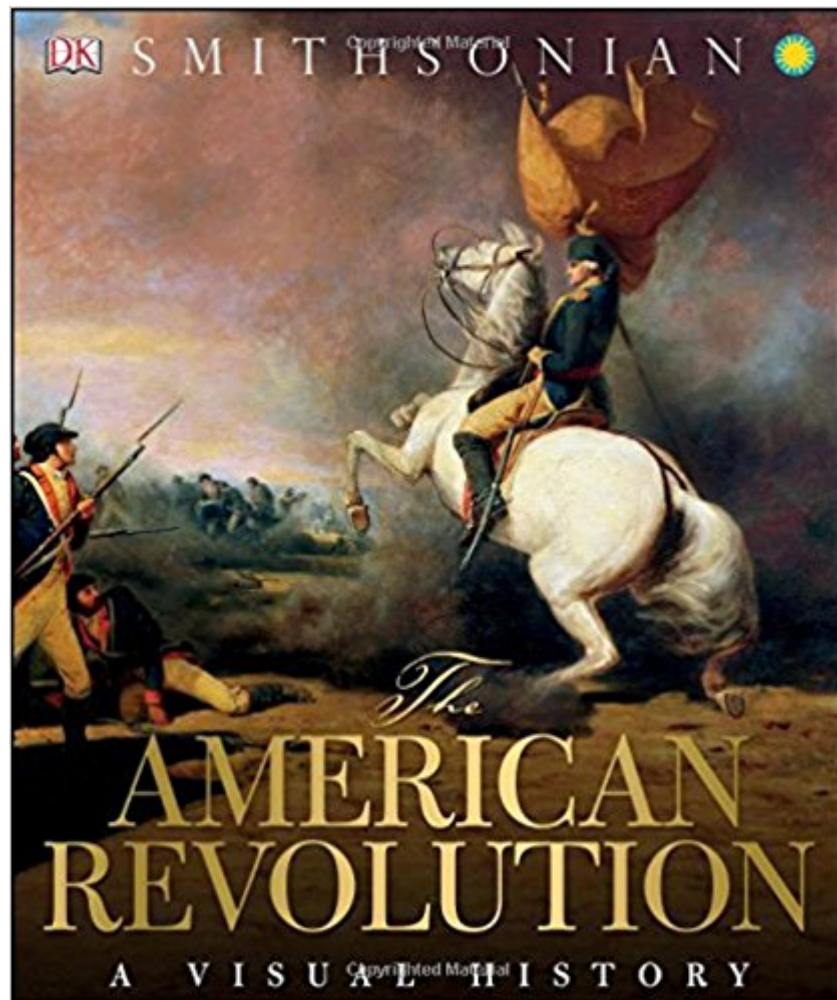




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The American Revolution: A Visual History

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Militia and the Continental Army

Throughout the War of Independence, American rebels would rely on two distinctly different types of military organizations on land: a standing, professional Continental Army, and less permanent bands of amateur citizen-soldiers—the militia.

The Execution of John André Sentenced to death by a military tribunal for inciting American General Benedict Arnold to commit treason, the British spy Major John André hoped to be shot like a soldier. Instead, he was hanged in a field in Tappan, New York. He faced the gibbet as only a gallant officer and gentleman could, deeply impressing the large crowd of onlookers, including many former enemies.

Guerilla War in South Carolina Away from the sieges and battles of the main armies, South Carolina witnessed a different kind of warfare in the backcountry—guerrilla attacks by Patriots on British forts and Loyalist communities.

Gr 7 Up Spanning from the period before the American Revolution to post-union creation, this oversize book is divided into nine sections, each of which begins with an introduction and time line. The topics cover important events and battles, different groups involved (including African and Native Americans), women of note, what life on each side was like, and equipment used (uniforms, arms, medical). Large color pictures, black-and-white drawings, and brief biographies of relevant individuals are interspersed throughout. There's enough content to give readers an understanding of why this historical period is important; some of the material will even give students a better grasp than textbooks used in secondary and lower-level college classes. The table of contents and the detailed index are ideal for finding information quickly.
