

I bought this book, but after looking at it, promptly sent it back. It was so confusing. A flip book? I felt like it was more appropriate for a kids game than to try to navigate through a confusing city like Tokyo.

I found this book to be rather useless. It offers very broad neighborhood snapshots to "create" your own day but very little detail. I can't imagine finding it useful to carry this book around Tokyo.

It's packaged nicely and works if you aren't using it to walk. The tiny streets are not identified, so I spent a whole day walking lost in Tokyo.

This was by far the best little travel book I've found. The directions, maps, suggestions and links and suggestions terrific.

This was a great accessory for my trip to Japan. It gave directions to the places, and best times to go. It even had a map of Tokyo.

This is a wonderful Tokyo guide book. It's just the right size. I bought it for my wife to use, but have ended up using it myself too.

Made it so simple to plan a two day trip.

What a waste of money! The physical concept of flip pages is great but a guide should have information. The blurb promised itineraries but a paragraph about Shibuya Crossing that only lists the JR line stop is weak. And only one restaurant recommendation per place in a city teeming with restaurants? No explanation of the Hachiko statue? A French restaurant is the recommended spot in the old geisha neighborhood. I'm sending this one back.
