

I hate to say it, but i hate this book! I should have returned it. It is not organized by color so it is almost impossible to use if you are trying to identify flowers. You have to look thru every page to find the match! Ridiculous! Wish i had my money back to buy a different book!

It is truly a Texas hill country wildflower guide. I friend of mine visiting the hill country sent me several email photos of delightful flowers she saw and asked me to identify them. (I am a Master Gardener in Oregon and Texas.) I saw reference to subject book via the "id wildflowers" web site and was referred to which had numerous used copies listed. It is a handy book, with just enough technical detail to aid in the identification process. Photos of wildflowers dominate the pages and provide for easy identification of hill country wildflowers or photos thereof.
