

Beverly Lewis, born in the heart of Pennsylvania Dutch country, is the New York Times bestselling author of more than eighty books. Her stories have been published in nine languages worldwide. A keen interest in her mother's Plain heritage has inspired Beverly to write many Amish-related novels, beginning with *The Shunning*, which has sold more than one million copies. The Brethren was honored with a 2007 Christy Award. Beverly lives with her husband, David, in Colorado.

In "Amish Prayers," Beverly Lewis provides English translations of a selection of prayers from "Die Ernsthafte Christenpflicht," an early eighteenth century prayer collection that has been treasured by the Amish and Mennonites for generations. Lewis's translations are sensitive to the Anabaptist theology reflected in the prayers, and her style is appropriately simple and straightforward. It's great to have this book available in Kindle format, so that these moving prayers are always handy.

Unfortunately, however, there is no table of contents, linked or otherwise. That makes it extremely difficult to find the kind of prayer you might be interested in. I got this book when it was free. It was weeks before I opened it, and oh what a treasure is between the covers! I come from a religious background where only pre-written prayers were used, and even as a child I just didn't understand why talking to God had to be "canned". I later learned about freely just praying from the heart, and praying the scriptures, and have shunned anything resembling the "canned" prayers of my past. As I began reading the prayers in this book, just to check it out, I was amazed! They are profound, spiritual, and open the heart to God. While not a substitute for spontaneous prayers, there is very much a place for these kind of biblically based, heart felt prayers. Perfect for family mealtimes; devotional time; or the beginning of a group prayer in bible studies.

One of my favorite topics/areas of interest since I have been a young person has been the Amish Community. I have been fascinated by them since I was about ten years old. When I was given the opportunity to review 'Amish Prayers,' compiled by Beverly Lewis, I knew I had to seize that opportunity! (p. 11) This book is separated by categories, including Prayers for Divine Guidance, Prayers of Gratitude, Prayers of Praise, Prayers for Strength, and Prayers of Unity. Here is an example of one of the Prayers for Divine Guidance: We ask You with our whole hearts, O holy, loving triune God in heaven, to build us up and establish us according to your hold will. Transform us and draw us mercifully to you. Aid us, that we may follow your commandments and serve you cheerfully and willfully. Be our gracious bridge and way. Ever set our hearts and minds on the path of your holy and divine peace so that we may willingly cling to you and serve you as your dear children. Amen. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress; My God; in Him will I trust. Psalm 91:2 (p. 31) This book includes beautiful pencil illustrations which enhance the simplicity and beauty of these prayers. This is a fairly small book which would easily fit into a purse or a laptop bag. It would make a terrific gift to give a dad or a grad, or anyone in between. The Amish have such wisdom, and couldn't we all use more wisdom?! I thank Ms. Lewis for compiling these prayers, and making them more accessible to the masses, and to keep these prayers alive in our hearts after being available for so many centuries.
