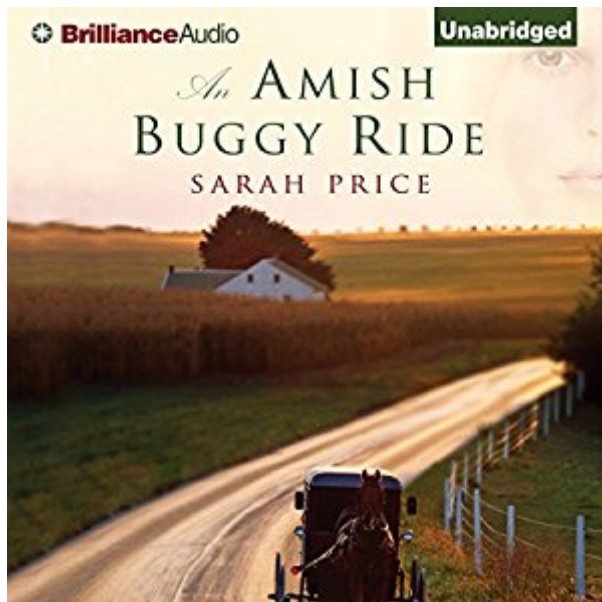


The book was found

Synopsis

Quiet and soft-spoken, Kate Zook is the responsible eldest daughter in an Amish family and prides herself on fulfilling her role. Then, one fateful snowy night, she uncharacteristically speaks her mind - and unwittingly plays a part in a horrible accident. Wracked by guilt over her role in the tragedy that left her brother David injured, Kate devotes herself to his care, going so far as to take on his chores in the fields. Even so, her brother's resentment toward her grows, and David torments Kate, making her increasingly isolated life even more difficult. Though Kate's parents have emotionally withdrawn, someone outside the home takes an interest in Kate and notes her clear grief. Samuel, a local boy, has recently returned from a wild rumschprunge - the Amish term for exploring the wider world - and recommitted to his community. Intrigued by Kate's gentle yet loyal ways, he begins to fall in love with her. But tensions rise as he refuses to put up with David's rage. As Kate's heart begins to stir and cry out for happiness, she must rely on faith to find forgiveness or risk losing out on love.

Kate's dark secret all but consumes her in this tender story of Amish life. She and her community must struggle with issues of honor, shame, accountability, and forgiveness. This book gently draws the reader into decisions about right and wrong, about love and duty. I enjoyed learning how the Amish community seeks to do the right thing not just for themselves, but for others as well. The book is well written and the main characters are likable. I would have liked less focus on the main character and a bit more insight into the other characters.

Sarah Price is an excellent author and "An Amish Buggy Ride" is a great example of why. The Zook family, from outward appearances, seems rather normal despite the trials they have faced. Yet they are as dysfunctional as many of our modern families. Kate and her family exist day to day keeping secret the guilty feelings that engulf them. It takes a determined other party to bring them to see the truth. It may have an Amish setting, but the story issue fits as well in any modern community. A great read, with opportunities for thought.
