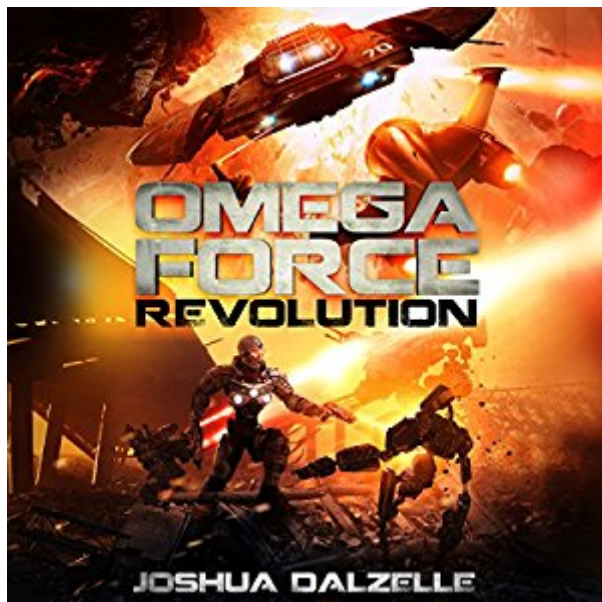

The story started off slow, but the OF team kicked into battle formation as to what they are known for. It's just takes to long between books . Regrettably, the author has decided to restricted future releases to what is the greatest story ever told.

Lucky is no longer a mystery. This book presents a strong historical reference for the battle synths. It dragged a little in places but overall, another outstanding Joshua Dalzelle read. In the Epilogue for this book, Joshua hints at a new series.

I was thrilled with the release of a new Omega Force book. The plot starts as a jog and ramps up quickly into a fierce race to find resources, ferret out information, while dealing with some bad guys.
