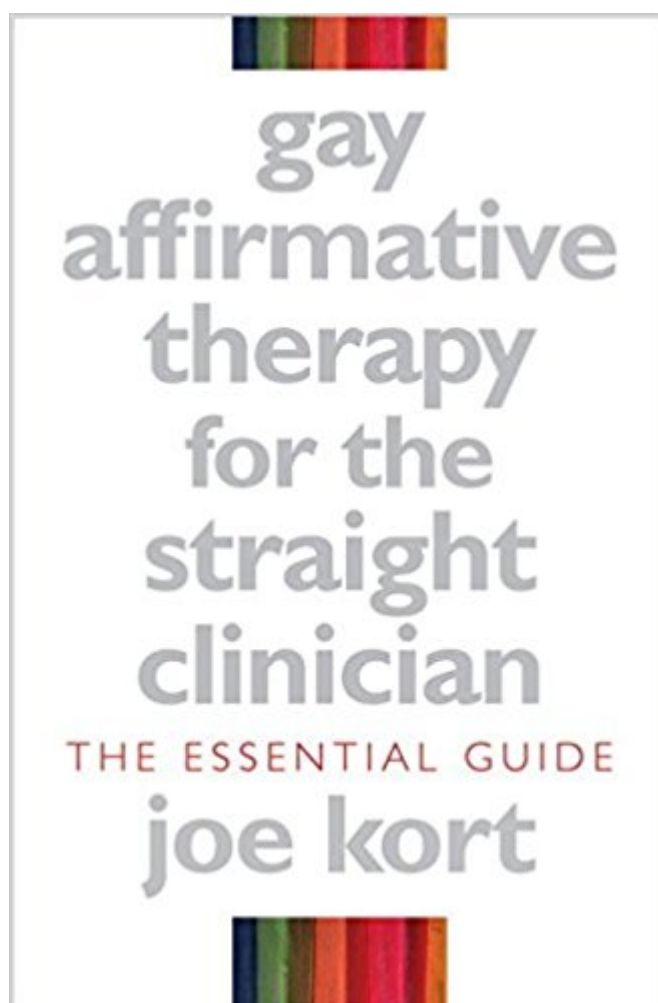

I realized I needed more familiarity with this. Covert cultural sexual abuse and its consequences were particularly helpful. He includes lots of case studies to illustrate points of all kinds.
