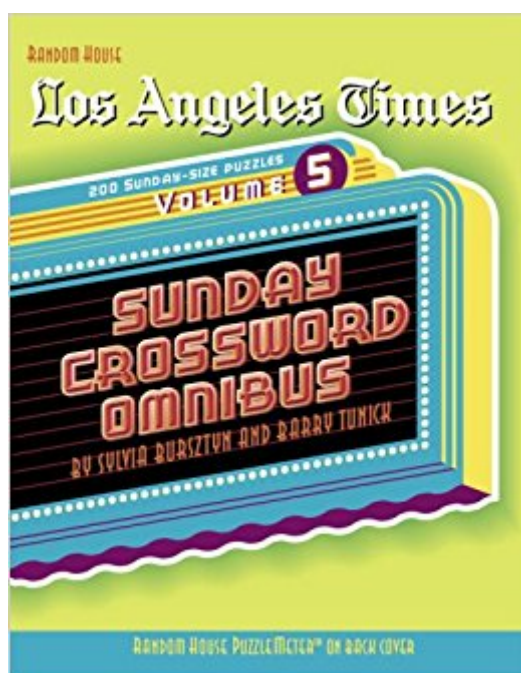

Bursztyn and Tunick return with volume 20 and their trademark wit and wordplay. The Sunday crosswords from the "Los Angeles Times duo have been enjoyed by west coast readers for years.

California residents Sylvia Bursztyn and Barry Tunick are nationally respected constructors who have created over one thousand crosswords over the past two decades.

I find the Los Angeles Times Sunday crossword puzzles stimulating; they present a big challenge that often times appear impossible, yet I usually can complete one without assistance. For me they are a stark contrast from New York Times puzzles which I find unsolvable without help; east coast vs west coast lingo? Seems like NYT invents words to suit the puzzle world.

Having done another volume of these puzzles the consistency is as expected. It's enjoyable in it's

level of complexity but not tasking to a NYT Sunday puzzle difficulty level or being peckish and natty in detail.

The grids are placed at the bottom of each page, leaving nowhere to rest the heel of your hand when filling in the squares. The grid should have been placed up above the clues.
