

I have to admit I haven't really read any other books on sports betting so this automatically makes it my favorite, but it is well written and packed with great info. Pat writes as though you are having a conversation with a good friend, and translates that into sports betting. There are tons of hilarious stories that any young man can that likes sports and women can most likely relate too. I'm not one for tons of statistics and anything that will put me to sleep, and this was a book that puts some great insight into translatable terms that was easy to read. The author also reached out to me after signing up for at his site, and was just as cool of a guy as you would think from the book. If you buy one book on football betting I recommend this one. His college picks are unbelievably spot on, and great insight for NFL picks too! I'm happy I grabbed this one, and think you probably should get it if you are considering. Does it help? Let me preface this review by stating that I am not a big reader... But, I love me some gambling. Unfortunately, I hit a rut this past year and couldn't pick a winner to save my life. So I tried following some touts on twitter/internet which proved to be just as bad, if not worse. Begrudgingly, I broke down and tried reading some books on the sports betting to try and sharpen my skills. I couldn't finish a single one. They all reminded me of the textbooks from my college days. riddled with statistical analysis and academia. Many were very outdated as well. Then I stumbled on Good Teams Win, Great Teams Cover. and I read it in one sitting (which I can honestly say is the only time I've ever done that). It was eye-opening (and a little sad) to see all of the traps I had been falling into - including the

aforementioned following of touts. It's also a hilarious read, which is part of the reason it's so hard to put down. The author has some crazy stories and he does a great job of intertwining them with the overarching theme for each chapter. It's too bad football season ended before I found this book, but I'm ready to use the things I learned from this book next season!

I'm the classic weekend gambler. I love the thrill of having some action on my favorite sporting events, but I'm too lazy to put the work in... And my bankroll / results have suffered because of it. Until I found this book. It's the only book I've found that has all the info you need to be consistently successful put together all in one place .. and written so the average Joe like me can understand it . It's truly a one stop shop. The chapter called "Sucker Bets" was written just for me.. I've fallen for everyone of these situations more than once.. I just can't help myself.. But this book is a great reference to use and make sure you're not being suckered by The Man. If you follow it, it will keep you on the sharp side !

Havent finished this book but not all that interesting so far. Informative for someone who hasnt gambled much and needs to learn a thing or two to NOT BE a square bettor. If you are a new bettor, may not be a bad book to read. Definitely doesn't hurt to read, no matter the material, about sports betting if you are a new or avid gambler. New perspectives are always nice.

I've been looking for a good book on sportsbetting to fuel my degeberate gambling habits and I randomly came by this book. I like supporting independently published books so I gave it a try. Sometimes these books suffer from poor editing and haphazard organization but not this one. Gambling jargon can be a little intimidating and confusing at times but Hagerty does a good job explaining things, providing a helpful appendix of key terms and splicing in anecdotes throughout to give real-life scenarios for gambling situations. Some of the anecdotes are quite funny; the one involving his brother pranking the school principle must be read to be believed. Overall, a good book for both the gambling novice and expert with enough colorfull writing to keep the readers attention throughout.

In fairness to the author, I write book reviews about as well as I gamble. Which, if you ask anyone that knows me, is marginal at best. Unlike my gambling abilities, however, the book is a fantastic read. Many gambling books attempt to give you advice by hitting you straight-up with a technical

discussion requiring some sort of advanced degree to process. The tips Pat shares here (good ones by the way) come at you from all angles as they are intertwined throughout stories where we can all see ourselves being *ÃƒÂ¢Ã ¬Ã œ* or at least dreaming of being *ÃƒÂ¢Ã ¬Ã œ* in PatÃƒÂ¢Ã ¬Ã œs shoes. The mix of entertainment and valuable, implementable advice is spot on. I highly recommend you read the book and see for yourself.
