

This book was incredible. The content was easy to digest and addressed many areas of topping which I had not considered as a novice. I have already re-read the book after reading some other bdsm literature and still find the book insightful and found aspects that I glossed over previously. Especially helpful for me were the interviews snippets and scenes, which helped me understand that some of my personal fears of being a top are shared by others and its not something that is wrong with me. I would heartily recommend this book to anyone interested in the scene.

If you are a top and are new to the BDSM lifestyle, the book is for you. It gives a brief overview of the many facets of the lifestyle and covers all the basic concepts, and gives excellent examples and scenarios you can try. Contains a glossary of terms & acronyms, as well as a resource guide pointing you to further research.

Quite an interesting read. The latter chapters on psychology were the parts I found most interesting and useful, and over all it's a well written book.

I had been looking for something like this but repeatedly came up empty. There are plenty of books on BDSM, but nothing that focuses on PLAY. I'm not here for spiritual awakening. Just some good clean (er...dirty) fun at this stage. No, I'm not entirely a Hedonist! If you plan to play or "scene", pick this up.
