It totally fits with the theme of how the summer going through her mother's things, and getting to know the beautiful Indy-Pop-Country singer who she is already a fan of and happens to own the cabin next door, changes her outlook, not only on the merits of the sleepy little resort town, but on life in general. Not to mention the prospects for love in her life, which up to this point had been fairly dim. The pacing and "feel" of the story are just about perfect. I love that there is minimal conflict in the narrative. Most of the drama comes from internal issues with the women, as opposed to arguments or jealousy or misunderstandings that could have been worked out with a bit of thoughtful conversation. Instead, they actually HAVE thoughtful conversation! Imagine that? Adults who act like they are adults? BRAVO!! I received an ARC copy of this book.

Reading a Nicolette Dane novel is always fun, but this may be the best yet. What started as a trip to liquidate her parent's lakefront summer home becomes a trip of new beginnings. Her neighbor at

the lake turns into a new relationship. Her feelings about the house turns from being her parents house into a part of her parent's legacy to her and her sister. But what Nicolette does best is to show us the emotional development of her characters. It seems that whenever I read a Nicolette Dane novel I watch people mature before my eyes. I can't wait for the next time a young lady appears in the pages of Nicolette's next novel so that I can watch her mature. I got this book for free in return for an unbiased review.

Another winner for Nico! This book delves into the possibility that change can be a good thing even if you don't want it to happen.
