

I enjoyed this book more for the memorabilia than for the recipes included. The recipes were interesting, but most could be found in any local community cookbook, or at least something very similar. They were not particularly speaking "cowboy" food. Still, it was terrific fun looking at the photos, reading the captions and finding out that one movie star or another ate the same potato casserole or whatever that our family ate. It brought back a lot of memories for me.

While this book has some really nice recipes there are too many errors in the proofreading. Temperatures are missing for baking, names are misspelled, run together words, too many mistakes in what could be a wonderful book.

This is fantastic it has a lot of recipes from western movie actors and family. And good stories too. Added information inside as well. I think ought to place this in the western movies collection because I don't think people know about this book. There are a lot of pictures too. A great price and received it fast. If you love the westerns and love recipes you should get this you will enjoy it too
