

So I can't really endorse Palast's final conclusions (it was tried and failed spectacularly in the USSR and Communist China), but the road he takes us on to get there is pretty interesting. I personally think his most important points are in the first 28 some pages with Interstate Crosscheck, but the whole of the book is worth reading. I don't believe anyone has successfully discredited Palast so far, in fact a lot of Republicans were crowing about Interstate Crosscheck before the election (now that it may have worked, no one seems to be saying anything about it).

To really understand why Democrats keep losing elections, in spite of being the majority of voters, you must read how the super wealthy manipulate the vote with dishonest ads, how they suppress the vote by implementing uncalled for Voter ID laws and how the process feeds on itself as more and more power ascend to the wealthy few.
