A deep dive into every facet of dance music production. I'd say this is more of an "Intermediate to Advanced" level book especially for dance music producers, not so much a beginners' general guide. If that's you, though, you'll get A LOT out of this book. Highly recommended.

The content in this book is great. Some stuff is basic, but not too basic. Other stuff is more advanced, but not too advanced. There's good balance in this book and the walk-throughs are interesting. The only problem I have with this book is its awkward shape. The pages are wide and heavy, which will sag if read like a regular book. Also, it doesn't help that the spine of this paperback

book feels weak. The best way to read this book is flat on a table top.
