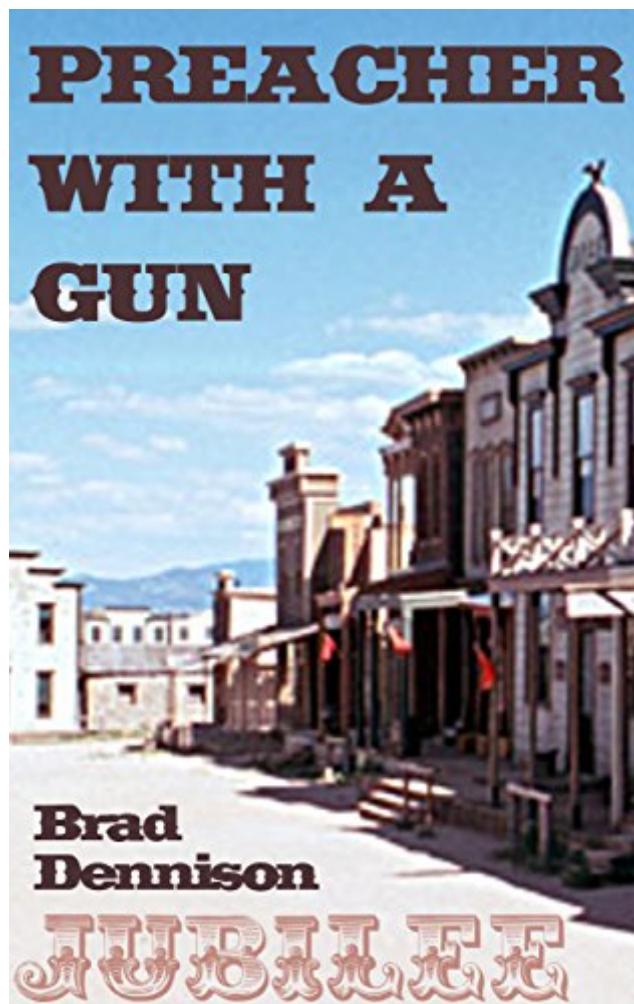

The protagonist, Tom McCabe while much like Glen Ford's character in Heaven with a Gun, does not come across as either a minister or a gunfighter. Tom's character did not hold my interest and it was difficult to finish this novel to find his fate. While we have become used to repetition in Mr. Dennison's novels this is worse than his other novels where the plot and the characters outways the repetitiveness.
