

I have been a fan of Mr. Thorpe's videos on YouTube (mostly camera reviews) for quite some time and this book did not disappoint. It is an excellent reference for any user of the OM-D E-M1 Mark II user regardless of skill level. I would highly recommend it instead of the Olympus manual as an aid to navigating the dauntingly complex menus of this camera.

I've been through the Olympus manual for the Olympus OM-D E-M1 MkII a number of times. Even created an Excel spreadsheet to show what defaults I'd changed as a reference in case my settings were wiped during a firmware update. But, I can't say I understood why the settings were there or

what they meant for my photography. Why should I set it up this way or that way and what scenarios were better for one setting or another. I've covered this book for all of the camera menus and learned a whole lot more about why my settings now make the most sense for the kind of photography I practice. I've tweaked a few of my settings based on this book to make it better for me. If you are like me, trying to figure out whether to use this setting or that setting I suggest you buy this book. There are typos and some grammatical errors, but that doesn't detract from the great content in the book.

In My Opinion, to basic but then again, this was targeted at someone that had never used this E-M1 MkII or the first E M1 before and I should say that this would be very helpful... for them! I did pick out a few tips that helped me out and thank David for that. Olympus has always been famous for preparing very confusing OE Manuals. Much has to do with the very different mindsets and ways at looking at instructions written by one country language into another, i.e. Japanese to American English.
