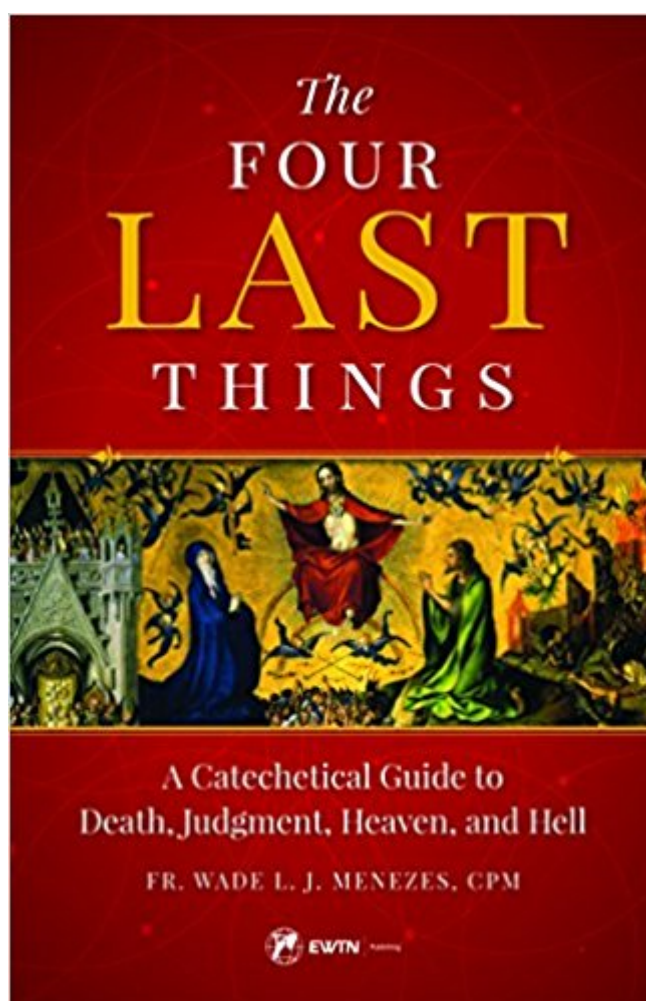


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The Four Last Things: A Catechetical Guide To Death, Judgment, Heaven, And Hell
