

Dorothy Mills turns Roman history into a tale of legend and academia that stretches far into the prehistory of the longest lasting and greatest civilization the world has ever known. Far from being "stuffy" and sometimes dull as history books often tend to be, "The Book of the Ancient Romans" reads somewhat like a novel, its characters and their adventures come to life and the glory that was Rome is described more lucidly and poetically than any other history book that I've ever read on this ancient people. The tales of the first seven Kings- a blend of legend and, undoubtedly, history- was my favorite part of the book. It left me yearning for a misty, mystical time when great societies were built on blood, honor and brotherhood. For those of us lucky enough to be the heirs of this
