

## Customer Reviews

The book is fairly informative and contains some good maps and pictures, but it lacks certain essential information on Tasmanian cities and towns (notably population, demographics, and weather averages/extremes). Also, a mileage chart for the distances between cities would have been helpful. Finally, the prices for motels, restaurants, attractions, etc, are confusing in that the "\$" sign used throughout the book is not defined -- are the prices quoted Australian dollars or U.S. dollars? Currently, there is a 34% difference in the exchange rate between the two currencies.

This is a wonderful guide to Tasmania. My wife and I spent a week touring the eastern part of Tasmania this year and this book was a fantastic help. After reading it from cover to cover to decide what we wanted to see, we cut out the pages of the sites we decided on visiting so we could fold them up and stick them in our pockets.
