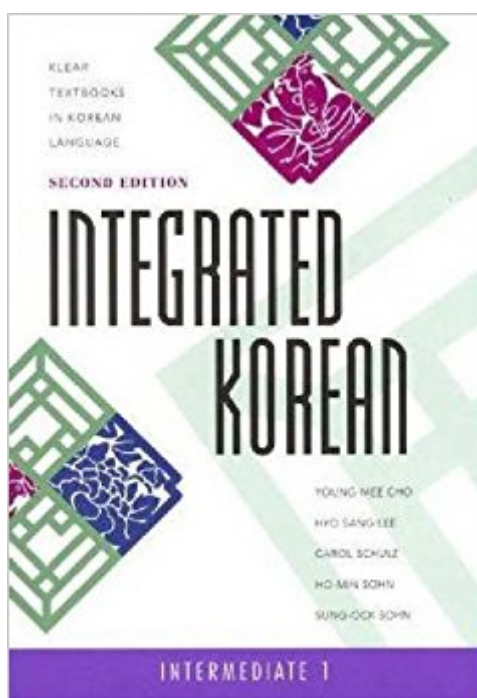

## Synopsis

This is a thoroughly revised edition of Integrated Korean: Intermediate 1, the third volume of the best-selling series developed collaboratively by leading classroom teachers and linguists of Korean. All series' volumes have been developed in accordance with performance-based principles and methodology--contextualization, learner-centeredness, use of authentic materials, usage-orientedness, balance between skill getting and skill using, and integration of speaking, listening, reading, writing, and culture. Grammar points are systematically introduced in simple but adequate explanations and abundant examples and exercises. Each situation/topic-based lesson of the main texts consists of model dialogues, narration, new words and expressions, vocabulary notes, culture, grammar, usage, and English translation of dialogues. In response to comments from hundreds of students and instructors of the first edition, this new edition features a more attractive two-color design with all new photos and drawings and an additional lesson and vocabulary exercises. Lessons are now organized into two main sections, each containing a conversational text (with its own vocabulary list) and a reading passage. The accompanying workbook, newly written, provides students with extensive skill-using activities based on the skills learned in the main text. I've been using this textbook and have previously used beginner 1 and 2 of the same set. They have been tremendously helpful, but also cannot reach their full potential without the matching workbooks. The publishers of this textbook provide really great audio files on their website that is meant to be used in conjunction with their books. There you can find audio versions of the conversations, which is useful for pronunciation. However, the one downside of this book is that I believe it is meant to be used within a classroom, so if you are looking to use this as a method to teach yourself Korean, you might have some difficulty understanding the explanations provided. It is not a bad book by any means, but you might need a little help which can be easily provided by the kind internet people.

The Korean Characters are all blank in the Kindle version on two different Android devices. Samsung Tablet and Pixel Phone. The disclaimer does say that not all devices will work, but it does seem to indicate that Android tablets and phones should work. How do you get help from ? It isn't clear where to lodge a complaint if anywhere? Just in case this was a one off I bought the kindle version of IK Intermediate 2. Same problem. Figured out how to get in touch with . There is a problem with the Kindle book. They are working on it.

Not the best language textbook, but one of the best of the few Korean ones out there. If this weren't the required book for my school, I probably wouldn't have bought it, but with a teacher's material to supplement everything I think it's pretty good. Anyone looking for something to self-study with might want to check out the Korea Grammar in Use series instead.

Great resource! As I said in my reviews of the workbooks, the textbooks should also have an answer key for the exercises given in each chapter. I eventually stopped doing them as I studied

because my professor doesn't grade them and there is no way for me to tell if I've gotten them correct.

I've been a beginner for around a year now and it's a great book as my commute is long. I don't have too many other opportunities to sit down and study other than during my commute and it's a resourceful text as everything that you need to know to complete it is within the book itself. If I must give a point of improvement, it'd be that they can provide more exercise examples within the textbook so that I don't have to spend more \$ on a separate workbook.

This review is for the Kindle version for Android App. The Korean font is in a handwriting font and thus makes it hard for a learner like me to read.

Great book for learning Korean. The accompanying website is a little lacking (needs to be updated), but overall a great buy. I do have a teacher that goes thru the book and workbook with me, but I think it would work perfectly for self-learners as well.

A useful book that has vocabulary for more everyday situations and has even more useful expressions than the previous books in the second edition. It might take more time to fully understand everything that is in this book though because there is more words than at the beginner level.
