One of the few reprint TROs that doesn't remove 'Mechs from the lineup. Bought the TRO 3039 because it combined several older TROs together, and was disapointed to find it was missing stats for favorites such as the Archer. TRO 3067 Reprint contains all the same material as the original release, but with the much nicer Catalyst cover. Notable 'Mechs include ones from the popular Mechwarrior 4, such as the Argus, Thanatos, Hellspawn, Osiris. Also included is the readout for the Perseus. For those who've played Mechwarrior 3, the Perseus is about as close as you will get to the MW3 version of the Orion, and can also be obtained as a miniature. Well laid out, thoughtful text, and excellent line art make the TRO: 3067 a staple for any 'Mech Head's shelf.

I've really enjoyed reading the Technical Readouts since I was a kid. Topps has made sure that the newer TOs live up to the quality of the ones in the past.
