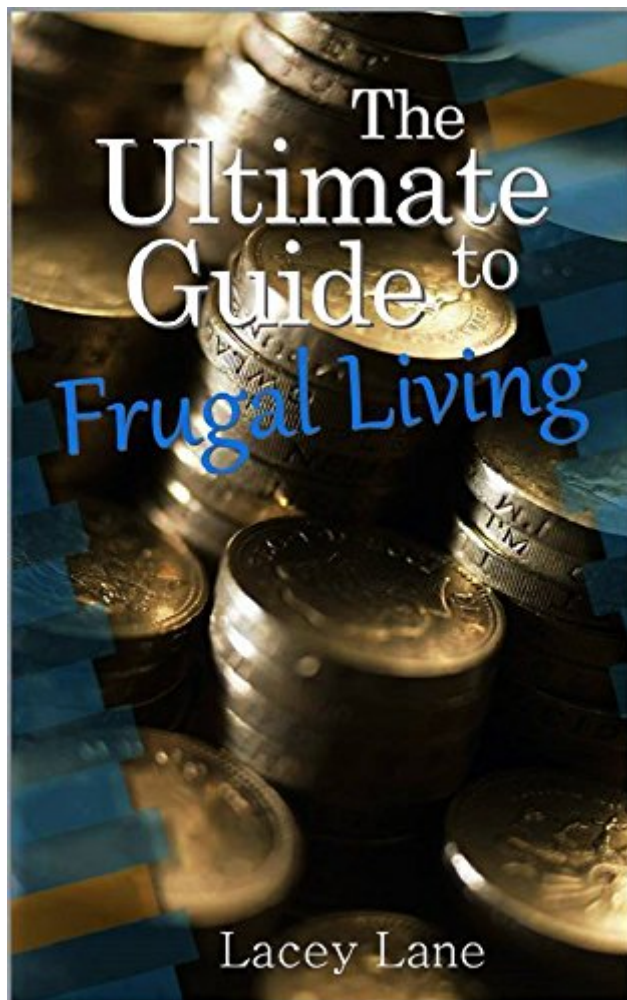

The Ultimate Guide to Frugal Living by Lacey Lane is a quick and helpful read that includes tips for saving money on energy, water, food, and car maintenance, along with an array of other typical expenses. Some of the author's strategies may not be for everyone, but there are several tips that any of us can use. After all, in today's economy, who doesn't like to set aside a few dollars here and there? I like that the author includes environmental-conscious suggestions and uses a simple list format that makes it easy to jot down

notes as you read. One of my favorite topics is the subject of conserving food. There are good notes on foods and produce that freeze well. Added to that is the safe length of time to keep frozen, and the subtle changes in textures or flavor that may occur. Another area in the guide that caught my attention is the suggestion of paying down debts, largest to smallest, and then focusing on the mortgage. Sound advice that is also recommended by a well-known author and talk-show host here in the U.S. If you are interested in some creative money saving tips, *The Ultimate Guide to Frugal Living* by Lacey Lane will certainly help with that!

This short book is full of practical tips that are not limited to the author's country but can be used in all developed parts of the world. It teaches us new ways of saving money and also our planet. These two objectives do not always go hand in hand (many ecological products are expensive and elsewhere I have heard tips on saving money that are clearly hurtful to the environment). But this book does succeed in showing us how to lead a more frugal life and be more in tune with nature at the same time. Some tips are rather technical and concern ways of cutting our bills for water and electricity, while other tips show us how to be more creative and lead a fulfilling and active life that is cheaper. Among many other things, you'll find inspiration regarding Christmas, weddings and vacations. A great book and a good price as well!

Though fairly brief, this book is packed with incredible ideas for saving money that even diehard spendthrifts like myself will find helpful. Some of the ideas were well-known to me, but a surprising amount of money-saving practices had never occurred to me. They aren't to be found in any energy-saving guides you commonly find at utility companies either or that come up quickly during google searches. So, considering the price, this is a gem of a deal. Considering how many people are struggling in this down economy, and how many more of those have kids, this book is a life-saver. Children can be taught very young, moreover, to implement many of the techniques, and to remind mom and dad when they forget.
