

I started the After Cilmeri series with the prequel, "Daughter of Time", and was hooked before I was done. I'm fascinated with time travel, especially when there's a next to impossible romance involved. I couldn't wait to get into "Footsteps..." & wasn't disappointed. Hard to tell how special it was without dropping spoilers, but let me say it was full of surprises. Ms. Woodbury weaves a tapestry of light & dark threads that culminate in an awe-inspiring picture. I really enjoyed it from start to finish (ok, maybe I fast-forwarded through some of the battle scenes, but that's just me).

I picked up this book a little apprehensively. I really liked the first one. I enjoyed the story told from Llywelyn and Magred POV and I worried it wouldn't be as good told from the kids POV. I was wrong! I loved it!!! The story still flows well and I really learned to like David, though I haven't really gotten to know Anna so much. This book is an easy read and I loved it a lot.

This was a fascinating book. I enjoy a storyline that takes me into the past, and this one did that and then some. It took me into a culture and time that I knew very little about before reading about it and the descriptions made it come alive in all its "gory" and glory. Definitely worth picking up for not only entertainment, but a little education thrown in too. I couldn't wait to read more about the characters in the story and immediately purchased another one of the books in the series.

I found that I was thinking about the story and characters later in the day and looking forward to getting back to the book. The twists and turns are intriguing and delightful. I am hooked! I recommend this series.

One of the most compelling points of this series is that when Anna and David save Llywelyn's life a new history is written. I like the idea of a "what could have been..." story. Anna and David are relatable characters and they both have the opportunity to be the hero.

Really love the history and storyline. I'm not usually a reader of history and this isn't a history book, but you can tell the author did her research. I liked the character's and their development. Sarah Woodbury moves the story along well while at the same time you get almost a history lesson. Love all the Welsh names. I bet this book would be even better as an audio book so you could hear the proper pronunciation of the Welsh words. I'm sure I'm not saying them correctly in my head! There's only thing I wish there had been more of in this story was more about Meg and Llewellyn. The first book in the series was about them and this continues it, but this book really their son David's story.

This is an interesting book, especially if one is interested in time travel. Some of the names and historical situations are a bit hard to follow if one isn't familiar with the history.
