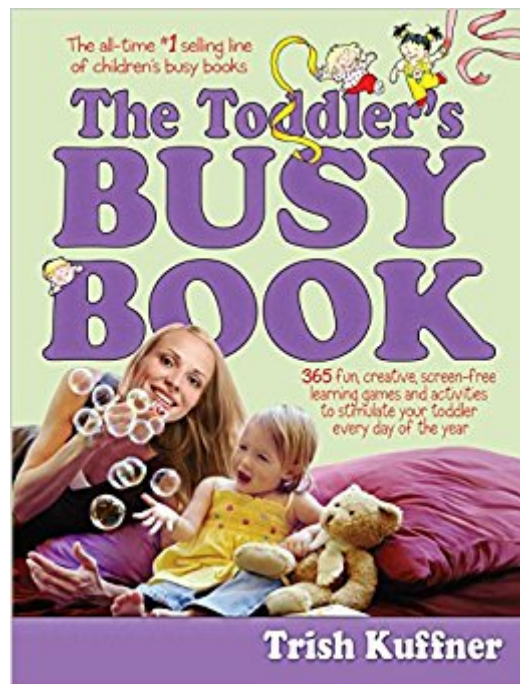

This book has some good ideas for kids 1yr - 3yrs. You really have to sift around the book and mark what works for your little ones, but it's super handy to have on a shelf and grab when you're kiddos are having a "boring" day. Some of the ideas need to be amended to fit diff age groups, but most are fine the way they are written. Out of lots of books I bought to help with those Mommy Needs Help days...this one is the best.

There is so much out there today that overwhelms children. This gets you back to basics with what you have at your own house. Like jello in the tub. Much easier to clean and they really like to feel it and play with it. Not having to run to the store for the products you already have at the house nice plus. Everyone has spaghetti or dishwashing detergent. It also covers various age groups and teaches them things that iPads and iPhones can't.

I was a little diasapointed in this book, there aren't very many creative activities. And a lot of them are just slight variants of each other so I didn't really get any new ideas.
